

# Building First-Generation Services Using TRIO Student Support Services as a Base

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) programs are designed to improve retention, graduation and transfer for first-generation students. However, campus leaders may become frustrated because TRIO services cannot be made available campus-wide. Facilitated by a team of TRIO professionals, this workshop will discuss the key elements of a TRIO SSS program and how this federally funded program can assist in building more comprehensive first-generation services to meet the needs of a college campus. You will examine the opportunities and limitations that TRIO regulations provide in serving both enrolled and non-enrolled students.

You will be exposed to several models where TRIO services have served as a base for a broader institutional commitment to first-generation students and how TRIO SSS programs are helping institutions leverage their support for first-generation students. You will also learn about the opportunity provided by the Fall/Winter 2019 competition for Student Support Services funds.
